

Welcome to the Club!

We are so excited that you are joining 4-H this year! You will “Learn to Do by Doing” with friends, supported by some of the caring adults in your community. We hope you have fun while learning new skills. As a member, you have responsibility to get involved in making plans and decisions for your club that guarantee everyone involved is included, has fun, and learns together.

There are some requirements for your membership:

Cleaver Kid expectations:

- Register in the Cleaver Kids project, set goals, and track progress
- Attend designated club and/or project activities
- Through hands-on learning, while exploring all 4-H has to offer:
 - Develop new friendships
 - Develop a sense of belonging to the club and the community
 - Develop listening skills and the ability to express thoughts and ideas

Junior, Intermediate, Senior minimum requirements:

- Register in a minimum of one project and complete project records and have them signed by the General or Project Leader, or designated adult volunteer.
 - In order to receive credit for more than one project, project records must be completed for each registered project.
- Attend a minimum of 70% of designated club activities.
- Complete a communications activity that is:
 - Prepared by the member.
 - Presented by the member in front of a 4-H group.
 - At least three minutes in length.
- Complete a club approved community service activity.
- Participate in the club’s achievement event(s).

Once your club has completed their registration with 4-H Alberta, you will receive an email with your username and password for your profile in the online registration system. Please log in and:

- Confirm that your personal information is correct
- Check your Canada Anti-Spam Legislation (CASL) agreement/disagreement.
 - 4-H Alberta, RR 1 Site 7 Box 1, Westeros AB T0C 2V0, collects your email address to be used to send you newsletters via email, event notifications, promotional information, and other information about 4-H. You must “agree” in order to receive these emails.
 - If you have multiple family members with the same email address it is best to agree on all individuals so that email information targeted to a specific age group is still received. Families will only receive one copy of an email sent to everyone, as duplicates are removed.
- Sign the Code of Conduct
- Complete the Health Forms and Program Agreement, in the event that you will be attending a regional or provincial program. These forms are good for one year.
- Complete the Release of Information form.
