Interstate batteries will pick up accumulated used batteries collected by 4-H clubs for disposal and pay the 4-H Club for their value. This is a responsible and useful way to keep our environment clean and recycle old materials. It's a helpful community service to neighbours and farmers who can have their old batteries taken away from their property by 4-H members.

Interstate Batteries adheres to EPA standards and is licensed to handle, haul and dispose of batteries and will indemnify 4-H clubs from any liability connected with this service. Concerns regarding the safe handling of dangerous goods by 4-H leaders and parents can be addressed upon request and basic guidelines are made available.

Procedure

- Contact Interstate Batteries to obtain information in regards to handling, transportation, and pick up, min #'s, prior to the collection.
- Have on central location for club members to drop off the batteries.
