Emergency Plan if Someone Becomes Sick at Your Event

If someone becomes sick at your event:

- Separate them from others as soon as possible and until they can go home. Provide them with clean, [disposable facemasks](#) to wear, if available. If not available, provide them with a cloth face covering, which can be improvised if needed from a tee shirt, bandana or other clothing, as well as a tissue or some other way to cover their coughs and sneezes.
- If needed, contact emergency services for those who need emergency care.
 - Public transportation, shared rides, and taxis should be avoided for sick persons.
- Be sure to contact local public health officials regarding the possible case of COVID-19 at your event and how to communicate with staff and attendees about possible exposure to the virus.
