

4-H on Parade Parking and Camping Passes

What you need to know

There are 3 types of passes you can purchase for 4-H on Parade:

\$10	1-Day Parking Pass	1-Day - This pass can be used to enter Stampede Park one time, any day of 4-H on Parade . This pass is often used to send to judges or officials or for buyers on the Sunday.
\$25	4-Day Parking Pass	4-Day - This pass allows the holder the opportunity to enter and exit Stampede Park multiple times throughout 4-H on Parade, starting on Thursday and running to Sunday. For most, this pass is the most economical.
\$35	Camping Pass	Camping - The camping pass provides a space for the pass holder to park their camper in the campground for 4-H on Parade. Camping units will be allowed to park in the designated club area starting at 9 am on Thursday, May 26th .

FAQs

Question: What services are provided for camping?

Each unit will be provided with power. Showers and toilets are also available in a building close by.

Question: If I have a motorhome and tow a car, what passes do I need?

You would need to purchase a camping pass and a 4-day parking pass. If you are going to use the trolley and not use your car to go back and forth to the barns, you would just need a camping pass. If you use the car to leave the grounds via the Nat Christie entrance and will not be entering the grounds any other way or driving to the barns, you will just require a camping pass.

Question: My horse trailer has living quarters; can I park my trailer in the infield and still sleep in it?

No, if you bring a livestock trailer with living quarters and plan to use it for sleeping, it needs to be parked in the camping area.

Question: Do I have to buy a parking pass to park my livestock trailer in the infield?

No, you do not have to buy a pass for your stock trailer.

Question: My daughter is driving, and she plans to drive back and forth to Stampede Park on her own. I will be driving on my own, how many parking passes do you suggest we purchase?

If each of you are going to be on park throughout the weekend, purchasing 2 4-day parking passes would likely be the most economical for you. If you are only going to be driving to the Stampede grounds once or twice over the weekend (and won't need to leave the grounds during the day), you may be able to get away with just a 1-day pass (or two if needed).
