



4-H on Parade Warm Up Arena Rules



1. Anyone using the warm up areas must be accompanied by an adult from their club who will be responsible for the conduct of those members in the warm up areas.
2. All riders must be appropriately dressed and have the proper tack on their horses while using the warm up areas. (Long sleeved shirts and pants, footwear with a heel, helmets if required. Bridles and saddles on the horses.)
3. An approved equestrian helmet must be worn by all members in Horsemanship Levels 1, 2 & 3, all members born in 2000 or later, and all English riders, while mounted.
4. Only 4-H members are allowed to ride in the warm-up areas.
5. No lungeing allowed.
6. No one on foot allowed in the riding area of the arena.
7. Horses must be led into the Mounting Area (designated area inside the arena gate) before mounting.
8. Slower horses use the outside track, faster horses use the inside track.
9. Pass other horses on the inside (**not** between the horse and the outside rail.)
10. Move to the center before stopping or for tack adjustments.
11. Pay attention to and follow instructions of the Warm Up Area supervisor as to how many horses are allowed in at one time. (Numbers will be restricted according to size of arena for safety purposes.)
12. All day Friday, and on Saturday and Sunday before the show, time allowed for each group will be set according to how many horses require the arena. When signalled to do so, please leave the arena to allow other members a chance to warm up.
13. During the show, only the class waiting to enter the hitching ring will be allowed in the warm-up area so that everyone will have a chance to warm up.
14. **Please remember that the volunteers supervising the warm up arenas are totally in charge and will enforce all rules.**

ANYONE ABUSING THE USE OF THE WARM UP AREAS OR SHOWING DISRESPECT TO THE SUPERVISORS WILL BE REPORTED TO THE SHOW COMMITTEE WHICH COULD RESULT IN SUSPENSION FROM THE SHOW.
