



## Consumer Decision Making (CDM) 2022



The Consumer Decision Making competition is open to all 4-H members in the Calgary Region. This competition will give 4-H members a chance to further improve their skills and abilities to make decisions and substantiate those decisions with oral reasons.

- Rules:**
- 1) Members are not to look at their cell phones during the contest. Members found to be looking at their phones will be asked to leave the competition and forfeit their entry fee.
  - 2) Clubs can enter as many interested members as they would like. This competition will be an all-oral reasons competition, so please make members aware of this and help them prepare accordingly. A good resource for this competition is the 4-H Judging CD!
  - 3) Contestants will be judging as individuals in five (5) classes. The committee has the right to change classes prior to the competition without alerting contestants. Contestants will then present five (5) sets of oral reasons to judges in each class. Classes may change slightly due to availability of subjects.
  - 4) Time allotted for placing and organizing your thoughts will be 15 minutes/class.
  - 5) No one but contestants, officials, score keepers and runners will be allowed in the judging area during the judging contest.
  - 6) Awards will be presented to the top Junior, top Intermediate and top Senior. Junior (9-11), Intermediate (12-14), and Seniors (15+) as of December 31 of the current 4-H year.
  - 7) Participants shall not inspect the classes prior to the contest. Judging will be done on an individual basis. **Anyone suspected of copying or conferring with others will be excused from the contest.**
  - 8) Each contestant shall be identified by a designated number and judges shall not question contestants on anything outside of the classes judged.
  - 9) Judging cards will be provided. Each contestant should bring his/her own pencil or pen.
  - 10) There is a **\$5.00** registration fee (payable to the Calgary Regional 4-H Council) and must accompany the registration.
  - 11) No late registrations will be accepted. Registration deadline is April 1<sup>st</sup>, 2022
  - 12) There shall be no writing on the judging cards prior to entering the ring. Any members doing so will be disqualified.
