



# 4-H on Parade Life Skills Competition 2022



**Life Skills is made up of nine (9) project competitions in 2022:**

1. Archery
2. Clothing and Textiles
3. Creative Arts
4. Foods
5. Photography
6. Skill Demonstration
7. Small Engines
8. Welding
9. Woodworking

Additionally, Life Skills members have the opportunity to compete in these other competitions:

- Silent Auction
- Multi-Judging
- Consumer Decision Making

## General Rules of the Competitions

**A \$2.00 entry fee applies to each entry**

1. **Archery** is open to all members registered in a 4-H archery project OR other 4-H project that incorporates an archery component and does not have a separate project competition. See attached rules. **Max: 1 entry**
2. **Clothing and Textiles** is open to all members registered in a 4-H clothing/textiles project. Participants in this competition may submit any original machine-sewn piece from their current project year. The competition will have a Junior, Intermediate and Senior category. **Max: 1 entry**
3. **Creative Arts** will include all creative mediums except those that have separate competitions – welding, photography, and woodworking. All members must be registered in a 4-H project that includes a creative component and does not have a separate project competition at 4-H on Parade. The competition will consist of three (3) class categories – see attached rules. **Max: 1 entry**
4. **Foods** is open to all members registered in a 4-H foods project OR other 4-H project that incorporates a food and/or nutrition component. The competition will consist of five class categories – see attached rules. **Max: 6 entries**

5. **Photography** is open to all members registered in a 4-H photography project. The competition will consist of six class categories. Members must indicate which category each photo is being entered into. See attached rules. **Max: 6 entries**
6. **Skill Demonstration** offers an opportunity to those members in projects not represented in the above categories to share their skills – see attached rules. **Max: 1 entry**
7. **Small Engines** is open to all members registered in a 4-H small engines project. The competition will occur on a specific day and time (to be determined) and each competitor will be required to demonstrate in person the skills they have learned. **Max: 1 entry**
8. **Welding** is open to all members registered in a 4-H welding project. The competition will consist of two class categories. **Max: 2 entries**
9. **Woodworking** is open to all members registered in a 4-H woodworking project. **Max: 1 entry**

### **Clothing & Textiles Rules and Guidelines:**

1. Members may enter only current year project work into the competition.
2. Any article sewn by the member using a machine may be entered into the competition.
3. Judges will award a Grand and Reserve Champion ribbon for each age category and then determine the Grand and Reserve Champion Prize winner from all entries.

## **Small Engine Competition Rules & Guidelines:**

We will be putting all you have learned this year with your engines to the test! Come prepared to diagnose, or build, or tinker! Any supplies and/or tools required will be provided. One Grand Champion and one Reserve Champion prize will be awarded.

Rules of the Competition:

- No outside technology allowed in the competition area.
- Only members, organizers and leaders are allowed in the competition area while the competition is occurring.

## **Welding Competition Rules & Guidelines:**

Two categories will be offered – Skills and Artistic

Members may enter only current year project work and may enter into both categories.

1. The skills competition will be judged on actual welds and other techniques learned in the project.
2. The artistic competition will be judged on the artistic value of the work only.

Each competitor will be required to submit a coupon, prior to the competition, for judging at a separate facility. The coupon requirement will be clarified with a dimensional drawing & description. This information will be sent out once members have registered for the competition.
