

4-H on Parade Steer Team Grooming



- 1. A maximum of three (3) teams may be entered from each 4-H club.
 - a. <u>Senior Team</u> = three (3) senior members aged 15-20
 - b. Intermediate Team = three (3) Intermediate members aged 12-14
 - c. Junior Team = three (3) Junior members aged 9-11. One Intermediate or Senior Level Coach
 - The Coach is for verbal instruction only. They are not allowed to touch the animal or equipment at anytime during the competition or the team will be disqualified.
 - d. All ages are as of January 1st.
 - e. Awards will be provided for Junior, Intermediate and Senior teams.
- 2. Choosing of the team grooming steers:
 - a. Each club will be able to choose up to 3 steers for team grooming, one each for Junior, Intermediate and Senior
 - b. Steers do not have to come from within the respective club but the club must have permission to use the steer
- 3. The animal may be pre-clipped. There will be **<u>no</u>** pre-fitting of any kind prior to entering the preparation area.
- 4. Grooming equipment, including blocking chutes, will be allowed in the preparation area.
- 5. Parents and 4-H Leaders will not be allowed in the preparation area during the competition, and coaching from the sidelines will result in disqualification of the club entry.
- 6. Each team will have 20 minutes to prepare their steer. The Judge(s) will be observing the procedure.
- 7. After 20 minutes the entries will parade in the ring and the Judge(s) will determine the placings.
