  - Must be elected by the club
  - Must complete 4-H Screening
  - Must complete Commit to Kids (Abuse Prevention and Duty to Report) and Youth Safety at 4-H in Canada training
  - Whenever working with youth, they must also have a second trained leader or a screened volunteer present.
- Screened Volunteer**
- Adults, not elected as leaders, but who wish to provide support to the club, district, region or provincial activities, and may also be perceived as holding a position of trust.
  - Must complete 4-H Screening
  - Must always have a Trained Leader present when working with youth
  - Is welcome to complete Commit to Kids and Youth Safety training
- Supporter**
- Adults, who do not wish to complete 4-H Screening
  - May not hold positions of trust.
  - May only volunteer under the supervision of a trained leader, and a second trained leader or a screened volunteer.
