



4-H Alberta 2024 Scholarship Application

2024 Post Secondary School Transcript

Post-Secondary Students do **NOT** have to provide high school transcripts. Request an Official Transcript from your post secondary institution with your final spring marks and email it to: scholarship@4hab.com no later than August 1, 2024.

All transcripts must be received by August 1, 2024 or you may be ineligible to receive a 4-H Scholarship. It is the responsibility of the applicant to ensure 4-H Alberta has received their transcript.

All applicants must submit an **OFFICIAL TRANSCRIPT** of their **FINAL** marks from their **last completed term**. **(ie. Winter or Spring)**

We encourage all applicants to order their transcripts no later than MAY 1, 2024 to ensure that the deadline has been met.

If we have not received your transcripts by **August 1, 2024**, then your application may not be considered for scholarships.

Please note:

- A Detailed Academic Report is NOT an Official Transcript
- If you are unable to have the transcripts emailed to scholarship@4hab.com, please email them to yourself and then forward them to scholarship@4hab.com
- If you only have the option to have your transcript sent **by mail**, the best practice is to have them mailed to yourself. Once you receive your transcript in the mail, you can take a photo or scan and email to scholarship@4hab.com.

HOW TO ORDER YOUR POST SECONDARY SCHOOL TRANSCRIPT:

The easiest way to obtain your transcript is to contact the Office of Registrar at your post secondary institution directly.

If your Post Secondary Institution has a student web portal, you may be able to access or request your transcript by logging into your school student portal.

Many Post Secondary Institutions use [MyCreds.ca](https://mycreds.ca) to send your transcript. If your are sending your post secondary transcript using MyCreds and have chosen a pin number, please email scholarship@4hab.com with the pin number you have chosen, so that we are able to access your transcript.

You may also be able to access your transcript using your post secondary school login information by logging into the [MyCreds portal](https://mycreds.ca).
