

National Young Cattleman - NYC



NYC stands for National Young Cattleman, and the NYC program is held each year in August at Bashaw, AB, as the concluding event of various other cattle shows where juniors have qualified to attend and compete in the NYC Competition. The NYC also challenges junior members (when referring to junior members it means cattle enthusiasts between ages 1-21) with various hands-on competitions that test the knowledge and expertise of various aspects of the cattle industry. Juniors are then judged on each component, and an aggregate scoring system is used. The members that will advance to represent 4-H on Parade at the Bashaw competition will be the top junior and top senior with the highest Aggregate score.

Juniors who compete at NYC are junior members who have qualified from Junior Shows throughout the year. The 4-H on Parade Female Show is a qualifying show. To have a show qualify, you must have these components:

- 1. Conformation
- 2. Showmanship
- 3. Judging
- 4. Another component, such as Marketing or Herdsman Quiz

4-H on Parade Female Show

To be eligible for NYC from the 4-H on Parade Beef Female show, you <u>must</u> <u>participate in all four of the following components:</u>

- 1. Conformation
- 2. Showmanship
- 3. Multi-Judging
- **4. Marketing**: A specific time for this component will be set, but members can come and go at their convenience to do this competition. Members will work on an activity individually and are judged on their completed project.
