

4-H on Parade Warmup Arena Rules



- Anyone using the warmup areas must be accompanied by an adult from their club who will be responsible for the conduct of those members in the warmup areas.
- 2. All riders must be appropriately dressed and have the proper tack on their horses while using the warmup areas.
 - a. (Sleeved shirts and pants, footwear with a heel, helmets, bridles and saddles on horses.)
- 3. Only 4-H members are allowed to ride in the warmup areas.
- 4. No lunging allowed.
- 5. No one on foot allowed in the riding area of the arena.
- 6. Horses must be led into the Mounting Area (designated area inside the arena gate) before mounting.
- 7. Slower horses use the outside track, faster horses use the inside track.
- 8. Pass other horses on the inside (**not** between the horse and the outside rail.)
- 9. Move to the center before stopping or for tack adjustments.
- 10. Pay attention to and follow instructions of the Warmup Area supervisor as to how many horses are allowed in at one time.
 - a. Numbers will be restricted according to size of arena for safety purposes.
- 11. Each day, prior to the show, time allowed for each group will be set according to how many horses require the arena. When signalled to do so, please leave the arena to allow other members a chance to warm up.
- 12. During the show, only the class waiting to enter the hitching ring will be allowed in the warm-up area so that everyone will have a chance to warm up.
- 13. Please remember that the volunteers supervising the warmup arenas are in charge and will enforce all rules.

ANYONE ABUSING THE USE OF THE WARMUP AREAS OR SHOWING DISRESPECT TO THE SUPERVISORS WILL BE REPORTED TO THE SHOW COMMITTEE WHICH COULD RESULT IN SUSPENSION FROM THE SHOW.
